

Frequently asked questions:

Q. How much does it cost to enter the Dandenong Show?

A. Adults \$15;
Pensioners/Students \$10; Children U14 \$7; Under 5 FREE; Family Ticket \$35 (2 adults & up to 4 children U14)

Q. What time does the Show open?

A. The Dandenong Show opens to the public at 9am each day. Saturday the pavilions close at 8.30pm and Sunday at 4pm.

Q. Is there an ATM machine available?

A. Unfortunately no – we have not been able to secure an ATM.

Q. What time are the fireworks?

A. The Dandenong Market Fireworks display is on Saturday at 9pm.

Q. Do you have disabled parking?

A. Disabled parking is available in Bennet Street Car Park.

Q. What is on the Main Arena?

A. There is a full program of horse events both days, with a special evening entertainment program on Saturday.

Q. Can I hire a stroller or wheelchair at the Dandenong Show?

A. Not at this stage.

Q. What showbags will be at the Dandenong Show?

A. Generally all the major showbags from the Royal Melbourne Show.

Q. Can I still buy a Dandenong Show Membership during the Show?

A. It would be better to purchase a membership prior to the Show.

Q. How can I get a job at the Dandenong Show?

A. Carnival operators and commercial exhibitors are responsible for hiring staff and we suggest you look out for any vacancies in the local print media and/or make your own enquiries with the operators.

Q. Can we bring our dog (pet) to the Show?

A. Sorry – no pets allowed (except where entered in competition)
