- > **STABLES:** Sorry no stabling is available.
 - > **CAMPING:** Anyone setting up overnight must camp where instructed by Committee or Stewards and definitely inside fenced areas.
 - > **All stallions are to be double tied to floats/trucks.**
 - > **APPROVED HELMETS MUST BE WORN WHILST MOUNTED.**
 - > **Exhibitors whilst at the show, work within the occupational health and safety legislation of the state of Victoria.**
 - > **Novice** means never to have won a similar class competing singularly at an affiliated agricultural show.
 - > **Open** means open to any horse that fits the height/age requirements of the class.
 - > **Champions** champion open saddle horses may not compete in show hunter classes. Once a horse has achieved a champion then it cannot compete in a similar class.
 - > **First season/newcomers** these events are open to horses who are eligible to compete in both VAS Ltd first season classes and Barastoc Newcomer classes. Horses are not eligible if previously shown under saddle prior to 1 January (first season) or 1st May (newcomer) of the current calendar year. Horses may only compete in these classes for one season at the beginning of their saddle career, open hacks are ineligible.

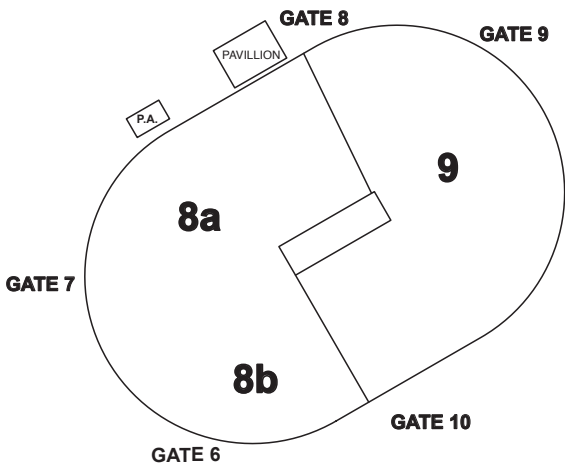

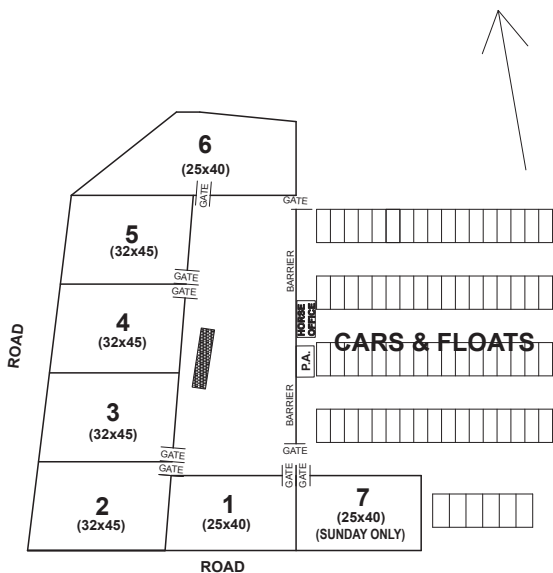
