### **PRIZE MONEY**

- Competition in ALL Cattle Classes is restricted to animals which are registered as Adults or in Calf Progeny Register of the respective Herd Book of Societies in Australia, or are Appendix animals where applicable, and will abide by their breed rules and ethics of showing.
- When completing entry form Cattle Exhibitors either sign waiver provided OR must provide a copy of Insurance Certificate of Currency.
- Please show the name of the animal on the entry form.
- The age of Beef Cattle is at the date of the Show each year.
- Most Successful exhibitor is calculated: 1st = 3 points, 2nd = 2 points, 3rd = 1 point.
- It is a Department of Primary Industries requirement that "All cattle leaving a property including cattle attending agricultural shows, must carry an NLIS tag at the time of dispatch".
- Please note there is limited power available. Please bring a generator if you wish.

### **EXHIBITORS, WHILST AT THE SHOW, WORK WITHIN THE OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH & SAFETY LEGISLATION OF THE STATE OF VICTORIA.**

#### **FOR REASONS OF OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH & SAFETY THE FOLLOWING RULES WILL APPLY:**

- All Bulls over 12 mths of age must be led by a ring through the nose
- Bulls 9-12 months must be led by a nose grip
- Bulls 12 months and over are to be led by a person over 18 years of age
- All beef females over 9 months must be led with a nose grip.
- All cattle are to be tethered by a halter and also secured by a neck strap.
- Cattle must be supervised by the owner/handler at all times.
- Smoking is not permitted in the cattle area.
- Alcohol and Drugs must not be consumed from time of arrival to time of departure.

## **Beef Cattle Parader & Judging Competitions**

### **Class 1327 VAS Ltd. Beef Cattle Parader Competition**

Show Level Beef Cattle Parading Rules & Regulations

1. Age of parader must be 8 years & over as of the day of the Show.
2. Parader must be attired in suitable clothing including solid shoes or boots.
3. The parader must lead a heifer under 2 years as of the day of the Show only.
4. Paraders animal must be eligible for breed registration with their respective breed society or entered in an ordinary class with details of exhibit on the respective Show/Event entry form for insurance purposes.
5. The judge may ask the parader to swap animals if required.
6. Adult or steward assistance is acceptable for a parader under 12 years. (Preferred that parents or siblings are not the assistance)
7. Competitions can be split into several age groups depending on the number of entries and level of experience.
8. Parader competitions are conducted under the VAS & ASA regulations.
